Morning tea consists of tea, coffee, cold drinks, Devonshire teas and a gf option.

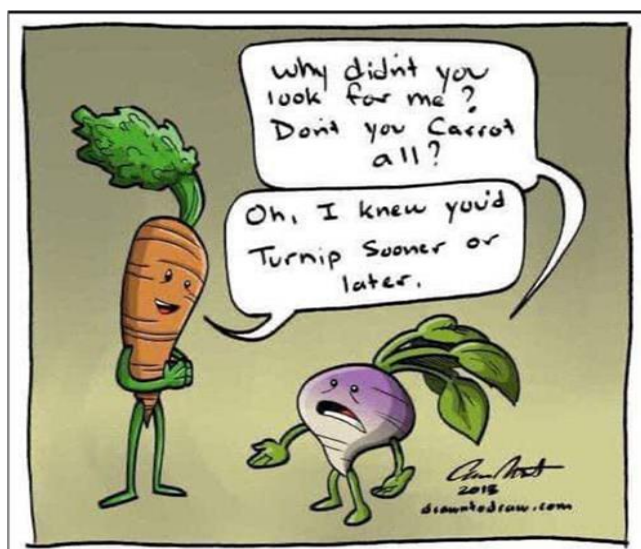
