Here is a photo of all the posy bowls made on the day. We all had fun arranging our bowls.



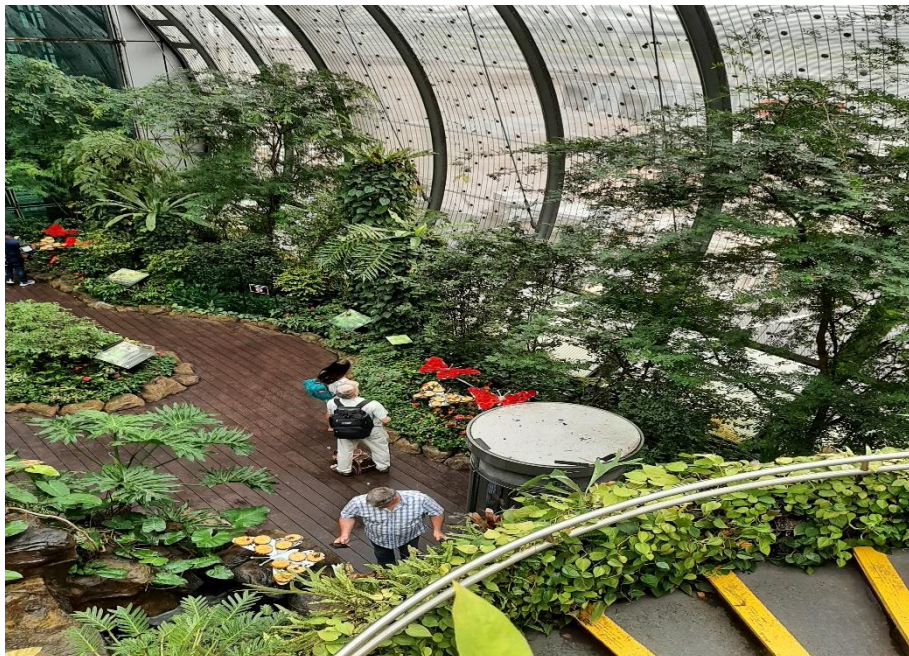
